Arrival & Dismissal

Before and after care will be offered this year to all Hinckley Preparatory Academy (HPA) students. Before care is from 7:00am – 7:30am, after care will run from 4:00pm – 6:00pm. School doors will open at 7:30 for those who do not elect for before care. Breakfast runs from 7:30am – 8:00am. Scholars are tardy as of 8:10am. Dismissal begins at 3:30pm per the guidelines below.

Parent drop off/pick up

Parents are to enter the parking lot and follow the orange cones around to the drop off/pick up locations which are run by HPA Staff. Scholars must be in FULL UNIFORM for arrival.

Early pick up

EVERY MINUTE MATTERS at HPA to ensure your scholar's future, our days are planned to the minute. Parents/guardians must contact the school prior to 2:30 PM to ensure proper notification/preparation for early release.

Yellow Bus/Daycare vans
